Abstract: This article talks about the attention paid to the issue of youth in our country, the work being done to train them in the profession, to reveal their talent in the field of their choice. Also, the information on the attention aimed at helping young people to know their history and forming practical skills for young historians is summarized.

In recent years, many innovations and reforms have been implemented in our country regarding the issue of young people, raising their intellectual potential, enriching their worldview, and revealing their talents, and a number of legal and regulatory documents have been adopted and put into practice.

According to the data of 2023, there will be more than 19 million young people under 30 years of age in the country or 55% of the population. While 600,000 young people enter the labor market every year, it is noted that this number will reach 1 million in the next 10 years.

From this point of view, special attention is paid to providing quality education, vocational training and employment to young people. A vertical management system was created for the organization of these works in the neighborhood. Dedicated and enterprising youth leaders were appointed to 9,500 neighborhoods. Through this system, more than 100 opportunities were created for young people, a targeted support system was established, and many young people were trained in professions.

As an example, it can be said that last year alone, 4 trillion soums of credit were given for youth entrepreneurship, 150,000 projects were launched, and 325,000 jobs were created. 43,000 hectares of arable land has been allocated and 435,000 youth employment has been provided. More than 32,000 young people were given equipment, tools and computers through subsidies.

Much work is also being done on social support. In particular, in 2022, 1 trillion 700 billion soums of educational loans were given to 130 thousand students, and women's master's studies became free of charge. 53,000 needy students were paid contract money, more than 15,000 young people were paid for military service, and 13,000 were paid for foreign language exams. Housing rent was allocated to 81 thousand students. About 600 billion soums of aid was provided to 300,000 young people through the "Youth Register".

Today, young people are very interested in learning foreign languages. 1.5 million young people devote their free time to learning a foreign language. Their aspirations are encouraged, and it is emphasized that subsidies will be allocated to the costs of language learning in private centers.

Also, in today's era of globalization, when the threats to youth education and consciousness are increasing, it is an important and priority task to protect young people from various foreign ideas.

It is no coincidence that Abdulla Avloni, one of our enlightened grandfathers, said that "the happiness of every nation depends on the good education of the youth."

Special attention is being paid to learning about our identity, culture, and history. As an example, in the University of Economics and Pedagogy in Karshi, various competitions, "Zakovat" intellectual games, and debates are constantly being organized among history students. Also, students regularly participate in various international and republican competitions.

In particular, in 2024, it is worth noting the example of the scientific-practical conference that will unite the historians of the republic. On August 11-19, the "Third Summer Study of Young Historians" organized in cooperation with the Youth Affairs Agency of the Institute of History was held. Young historians from different regions of our country, researchers headed by the rector of Pamukkale University of Turkey and researchers of Najmuddin Erbakan University took part in it.

Director of the Institute of History, academician Azamat Ziya, who spoke at the opening ceremony of the summer studies, expressed his opinion about the main goal of these summer studies, bringing together young historians in our country to take the research of the history of Uzbek statehood to a new level and the importance of history in educating the young generation to be patriots. After that, the rector of Pamukkale University, professor Ahmet Qutluhan spoke and expressed his opinion about the support of Uzbekistan-Turkey cooperation and the further expansion of scientific projects with the participation of historians of the two countries.

As part of the "Third Summer Readings of Young Historians", historians-scientists selected the most relevant and widely researched topics in the history of Uzbek statehood, which not only historians, young researchers, but our entire nation must know. In it, Doctor of History, Professor Shopolat Shaidullaev on the topic "Archaeology of the History of the Uzbek People and Statehood", Doctor of History, Professor Kahramon Rajabov on the topic "National Liberation Movements and Repressions", Doctor of History, Professor Muhaiyo Isakova and Doctor of History Feruz Boboev. "Political, social and economic tricks of the Soviet authorities against the Uzbek people" by Doctor of History Feruz Boboev and senior researcher of the institute Nizomiddin Gulboev on the topic "History of National Military Work" by Professor Alisher Kholiyrov of the American University in Sharjah and PhD student Henry Misa of Ohio University in the USA - Impact of the environment on economic changes in Turkestan (10th - 19th centuries)" and Dr. Dilnoza Jamolova's lectures on "National movement of modernism: purpose, history, lessons" were heard.

During the master classes held within the framework of this conference, young historians received answers to the questions they were interested in, and books were presented to active young historians by the speaking scientists.

At the final event of the summer studies, the Institute of History of the Academy of Sciences of Uzbekistan and the Youth Affairs Agency of the Republic of Uzbekistan awarded "Honours" to the participants of the third summer study of young historians of Uzbekistan.

In conclusion, it can be noted that today, practical work is being done for young people, to make them truly perfect individuals, mature specialists in their field. As mentioned above, it can be seen that the issue of youth has risen to the level of state policy.
