The parts of the exercise are referred to in methodological literature as "exercise requirements (titles) " and "exercise material." The exercise material can be written in the textbook (letter, word, sentence, graphic text) or a product of the student's speech (sound, word, sentence, oral text). A dynamic exercise is a learning activity performed by a student in a foreign language, ranging from writing a letter or pronouncing a sound to perceiving and understanding the text or freely expressing their thoughts.

This article concludes that, as we live in an era of advanced information technologies, it is necessary to teach foreign languages more perfectly in a way that is understandable to everyone, using these conveniences wisely. Consequently, the implementation of technologies and ensuring that teaching methods meet the demands of the time are the urgent primary tasks of pedagogical scientists.
