The first of these 5 important initiatives is aimed at increasing the interest of young people in music, painting, literature, theater and other fields of art. In particular, the first initiative is to increase the interest of young people in music, painting, literature, theater and other arts, to reveal their talents, the second initiative is to create the necessary conditions for physical training and sports, the third initiative is to promote computer technology and the Internet. The fourth initiative is devoted to such important issues as raising the morale of young people, the organization of systematic work to promote reading among them, the fifth initiative is dedicated to the employment of women, and the systematic practical work among young people in this regard. plays an important role in the output.

In this regard, music and other fields of art have a special place in raising the spirituality of our youth, enriching their aesthetic outlook. Introduction of technical and innovative means to music culture in the world's leading research centers, infrastructure of musical activity (composer-performer-listener) in the context of global media culture development, features of 21st century music listening culture, musical thinking, musical language, psychology of music perception and perception, in the context of spiritual culture, special attention is paid to issues such as music and fine arts.

In particular, it should be noted that in recent years in our country a number of reforms are being carried out for the development of the industry, its content and significance. As a result of these reforms, the tradition of directing our talented young people in many national and international competitions to reveal the talents of young people, to evaluate and reward their activities, and to introduce the tradition of "teacher-student" in the field. The harmonious combination of traditional and modern aspects of music culture and other spheres of art serves for its manifestation and preservation and development in a new color, a new perspective.

In particular, on June 30, 2020, the Ministry of Culture of Uzbekistan organized a republican festival "Cultural Life in Youth" on the occasion of "Youth Day". At the festival, more than 1,130 works were presented to the jury. The online festival showcased unique national and contemporary music. According to the jury, the young artists from different regions of the country were declared the absolute winners.

In particular, Shirinbaeva Umidahon from Samarkand region in the category "Best Piano & Dutor battle", Khushvaqtov Akhrorjon from Kashkadarya region in the category "Best Cover & DJ & Big Box", "Best cultural life among young people - Cultural life among Pirimov Sardorbek, another young talent from Kashkadarya region, and Abdujabborov Behzodjon from Tashkent, author of photographs entitled "The best cultural life, in black and white - Cultural life, in white and black". participants were declared winners.

Kasimov Ulugbek from Namangan region, Hasanov Marufjon from Tashkent, Mirmanov Berdakh from Karakalpakstan, Egamberdiev Muhammad from Tashkent and Sobirov Bobirjon from Samarkand region took an active part in the festival and were recognized by the jury for their creative work. were awarded a certificate of honor. Such competitions serve young people to understand the harmony of national and modern music, its attractiveness, originality and to discover the representatives of talent and talent.

The importance of international cooperation in the promotion of young artists and talents not only in our country, but also around the world is invaluable.

In particular, speaking about this, from the first years of independence of our country, international cultural relations have been established and practical work has been carried out step by step. It is no secret that in the following years, the organization and implementation of such work is being carried out rapidly, at a high level. For example, on September 12, 2017, during the Days of Culture of Uzbekistan dedicated to the 25th anniversary of relations between Russia and Uzbekistan, ensembles "Uzbekistan" and "Navbahor", folk music ensemble "Maqom", group "Uzbegim", Youth Symphony Orchestra of Uzbekistan, Farrukh Zokirov Yalla vocal and instrumental ensembles led by Famous Uzbek opera soloists also performed arias

from the operas of Mozart, Verdi and J. Puccini.

Besides, a roundtable "Cultural heritage of Uzbekistan in the collections of the Russian Federation" was held at the All-Russian Museum of Applied Decorative and Folk Art. As part of the roundtable, a presentation of a five-volume edition of "Cultural Heritage of Uzbekistan in World Collections" was held for leading museums and libraries of Russia. In addition, an exhibition of Uzbek works of art opened at the museum on the same day. The Days of Culture ended on September 14 with a concert program of Uzbek artists, and the participants were impressed by the unique masterpieces of Uzbek and world music, performed by masters and young people of our country.

In addition, the XII International Military Music Festival "Spasskaya Bashnya", which brings together representatives of different nationalities and ethnic groups, was held in Moscow in 2019, which will host many international competitions and festivals. As part of the music festival, special attention was paid to children's creativity in the youth project. Their creative products were widely displayed. In particular, the main goal of the special project of the international military festival "Spasskaya bashnya detyam" is to popularize the music of wind instruments among all segments of the population and to promote its rich history. In 2019, along with 23 Russian musical groups, 3 foreign orchestras, including an orchestra from Uzbekistan, demonstrated their performance skills at the VI International Festival.

For the first time at the invitation of the artistic directors of the festival E.Yu. Nikitin and V.A. Krilova took part in the festival "Youth Drum Orchestra" of the Republican Specialized Music Academic Lyceum of the National Guard of Uzbekistan in Russia. The orchestra's repertoire includes more than 100 works of various genres, including anthems, marches and fanfare, jazz compositions, folk and even authorial works. The youth orchestra is a laureate of a number of international and national competitions.

In addition to the program set on the international stage of the Children's Festival, our young orchestra has repeatedly demonstrated their skills and won the recognition of thousands of spectators, thanks to the numerous requests of the audience.

Although our musical team participated in this festival for the first time, it was warmly applauded by local and foreign participants for its skillful performance of compositions of various genres, and the talent of the National Guard Youth Orchestra was highly appreciated by the organizers.

"We are very glad that the youth music group from Tashkent is a participant of our festival. My impressions of the performance skills of such talented young people are unique. In the history of our children's festival, no one has ever been able to take the stage 4 times in 3 days and win the hearts of all the spectators. All musical performances of the orchestra were performed at the request of the audience, "said the conductor of the orchestra of the President of the Russian Federation, artistic director of the international festival" Spasskaya bashnya detyam ", Honored Artist of Russia, Colonel E.Yu. Nikitin.

At the end of the event, Nikitin presented diplomas to each group participating in the festival and visited the sights of Moscow, the Kremlin Palace, Alexander Park, Moscow Central Zoo, a tour of the city, as well as the President of the Russian National Guard Mikhail Sholokhov. an excursion to the museum of the cadet school was organized.

During the trip, performers of the Youth Drum Orchestra performed a small musical program for local and foreign guests of Moscow at the Vorobyovi Gori Square. The program, which included popular folk songs, the popular Katyusha and Victory Day military songs, amazed nearly 1,000 viewers.

The diligent study of the secrets of the art of music by the youth of Uzbekistan and the demonstration of their talents on a global scale is primarily the result of the ongoing systemic reforms, the conditions created by our state for young people to realize their intellectual potential.

A number of changes and innovations are being carried out in all spheres of the education system in the country. Today, special schools of music and art, strengthening its material and technical base, selection of young talents, orientation on their talents and abilities are being carried out. In particular, the participation and achievements of students of specialized art schools-Internet and other specialized music schools in competitions around the world are continuing and gaining a number of achievements. This paves the way for the development of the industry, for young people to develop their musical abilities.

In particular, on March 30, 2021 in Italy with the support and participation of the Embassy of our country was held a competition of young musicians and singers of Uzbekistan "Angeli". It was attended by

students of the Republican Specialized Boarding School of Arts and the Specialized Music School named after Uspensky.

The contest was organized by Aida Abdullaeva, an Italian artist, a member of the Verbumlandiart Cultural Association and the founder of the Angeli charity project. contributing to the development of relationships. As part of the project, a festival-competition of young Uzbek artists and designers was held in December 2020, and new names were discovered.

The music festival was held online and featured Uzbek Ambassador to Italy Otabek Akbarov, Kathy Prefect (Italian government) Antonio Fordjone, Aimart International Academy of Music and Arts Edda Silvestri, Verbumlandiart Cultural Association Chairman and VerbumPress Editor Regina Resta. , Chairman of the Academy of Arts of Uzbekistan Akmal Nuriddinov, Vice-Rector of the State Conservatory of Uzbekistan Sayyora Gafurova, Director of the Uspensky Specialized Music School Dildora Jamolova, Deputy Director of the Republican Specialized Art Boarding School Soyibjon Nigmatov, a number of famous Italian musicians, composers and vocalists.

O.Akbarov spoke about the development of culture and art in our country, the establishment of modern cultural and art institutions on the basis of advanced international experience, the systematic work to support talented youth, raising the cultural level of youth, providing them with the best examples of national and world culture. On this basis, a large-scale work is being carried out to nurture spiritually mature, harmoniously developed individuals, to realize the abilities and potential of young talents.

Aida Abdullaeva, the founder of the Angeli project, said that this international online music competition will contribute to strengthening cultural and humanitarian ties between Uzbekistan and Italy, creating a basis for creative growth and harmonious development of talented youth.

Katie County Prefect Armando Fordjone spoke about the role of art, including music, in raising human spirituality, inculcating noble ideas in his heart and mind, strengthening friendship and solidarity between peoples, and strengthening cultural and enlightenment ties.
